PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

Hello again to the Central California Emmaus Community.

As I prepare to go inside the walls of the world's highest maximum security prison for women, I am reminded of how much my Savior loves me. He is my Teacher, my Guide and my Counsel. I can trust Him -- I mean really trust Him -- to never, never leave me nor to fail me. He always comes through and I count on that each day.

As a religious volunteer at Valley State Prison for Women, I depend on donations for my share of the 400 dozen cookies that we take to the residents. In the past six years I have always had more than my share of donations but somehow this time I failed to even ask those around me to participate in this amazing ministry. Our household, too, is affected by the economic slowdown and I was trying to figure a way to squeeze out a few more dollars for cookies. I mentioned (actually I was whining) this to a few of my fellow Emmaus pilgrims at Celebrate Recovery last week and playfully held out my hands for donations. To my total amazement, the conversation did not skip a beat and even a woman walking by put money into my hands! I needed about \$50.00. Guess how much I received? \$52.00!! I guess I had quite a shocked look on my face because my friends told me on Sunday that it was priceless.

Why was I so shocked? I know the One who wants to supply ALL my needs. Didn't He say to ask Him believing?

Let me tell you about the cookies . . . why we take in so many. I have come to call them "forgiveness" cookies. We pile them onto plates the first afternoon when we meet the women. They make great ice-breakers. Some of the women load up their plates and then just sit and stare at them, taking a deep breath as they savor the aroma of fresh, yummy cookies. Some wrap them up in a napkin and stuff them in their pockets. Others, like me, just eat them!

By the end of the evening we wrap up a dozen in a gift bag and send them back with them to their place for the night. The next day we pile on more at every break and when it is time for them to leave, we again give them a dozen cookies for themselves. We add a second dozen for them to take and give to someone from whom they need to seek forgiveness. It could be the correctional officer, or their co-defendant, or their roommate. Whoever gets them feels the love and forgiveness of cookies. Hey, God can use whatever means He wants to open the hearts of those He has chosen and those He loves. I am so glad!

Enjoy the summer. Spend time with family. Pray for each other and for our Country. I am looking forward to seeing you at a Gathering or the next set of Walks.

General Reminders

1. Those working on a live-in team (kitchen or agape) for the very first time ***must*** attend both team meetings. There are no exceptions.
2. Those who are serving on one of the live-in teams during a Walk, ***must*** stay on site all weekend. Even if you live close to the Walk location, you may not go home to shower, etc.
3. ***Only single-size*** air mattresses, cots, Aerobeds, etc., may be used. This applies to all team members and pilgrims. If you bring a double-wide, be prepared to be assigned a bedmate!
4. If you're working for the first time, don't be afraid to ask questions. Every person on your team was once in your position and understands how you feel. If you don't understand an instruction, please ask.

GUIDELINES

- Sending in Work Requests early is very important. However, please keep in mind that being qualified and sending in a Work Request does not guarantee you a spot on any team. Each position is prayerfully considered.
- These guidelines are repeated in every newsletter as a reminder for those who may have forgotten and for those who are new to the Community.

1

First, you must serve at least twice on one of the **live-in action teams** (Kitchen or Agape)

2

This makes you qualified to serve as a **Silent Table Leader** in the Talk Room or as ***Sound Tech**

3

This makes you qualified to be a **Designated Table Leader/ Speaker** or a **Cha-Cha**

6

To be qualified as a **Lay Director** candidate you must have progressed through steps 1-4, given 2 Talks, & served as a Cha-Cha or Assist. LD

Lay Directors are prayerfully selected by the Board

5

To be an **Assistant Lay Director** you should have progressed through steps 1-3 and have given at least one Talk

4

This makes you qualified to serve as a **Core Team Boss** for a live-in action team or for the Love Team

One of the magical things about Emmaus is that everyone is on the same level. Yes, you may serve once as LD, but then you go back to working on teams -- and no team position is any greater or less than another.

**The position of Sound Tech requires special training and those individuals are considered members of the Song Team while on a Walk. This position is also considered equal with that of Silent Table Leader and thus qualifies those who serve as Sound Tech to be available to serve as a speaker or Cha Cha.*

Table leader assignments are made with care and are given to those who have proven the ability to lead a group, understand Emmaus, listen, empathize, guide discussion and foster the development of the table family.

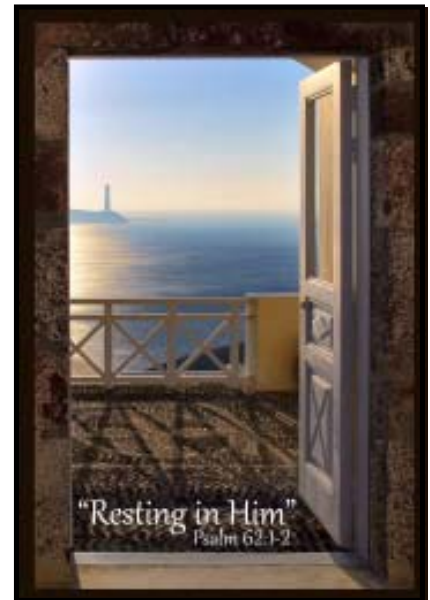

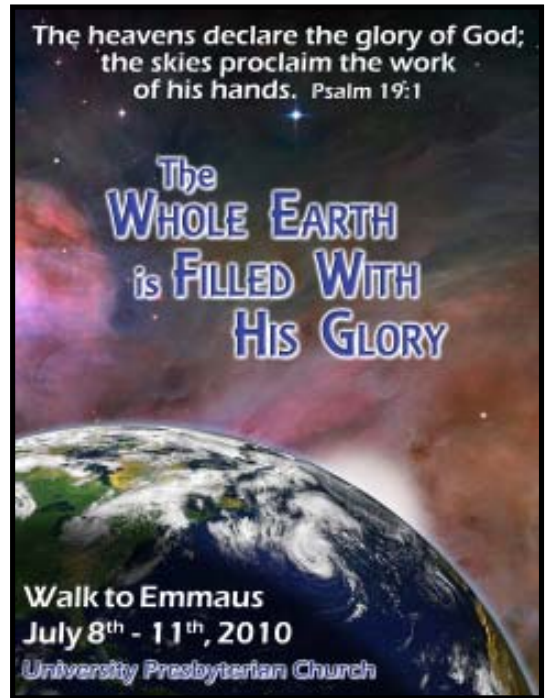

Tips on being a good sponsor

When you are considering sponsoring someone who is married, be sure you talk with both husband and wife. The decision to attend a Walk should be a joint one and their application must reflect their attending together.



From the very beginning, make your pilgrim(s) feel loved and that you are sincerely interested in them and their success at the Walk. Answer all their questions honestly. On the evening of the Walk take them to dinner, bring them to the site for a warm send-off, help them get their sleeping area settled and their registration taken care of. Then, when they have been led to the Talk Room to begin the Walk, attend the Sponsor Prayer Service.

During the weekend, you and your family become a substitute for either the husband or wife who are at home. Leave your phone number. Do something special for them during the weekend -- like giving them a few hours out during the day for personal time (especially if they have children). Share a meal with them.

Pray. Pray. Pray for your pilgrim throughout the weekend. Write letters and collect agape from family members and friends. Attend the Candlelight Service, Mananitas, and Closing. Think about what was important to you on your own Walk and do those things for your pilgrim(s). You are nurturing those who will be future sponsors.

Calling all musicians & vocalists . . .



If you are willing to share your talents with the Emmaus Community and serve on a song team at the Walks, please email or call the Board Music Coordinator, Bruce Wessels, and let him know your range of abilities. This information will then be compiled and made available to future song bosses, thus streamlining the process of putting together a team. Register ALL past work experience on your work requests

We are attempting to create data bases which list past team experience for every person in our Community. This will be extremely helpful for future LDs and team selection coordinators. Having a list of **all** those who are eligible for chas, speakers, table leaders, etc., will be a wonderful tool for the LDs in filling all their slots according to Emmaus guidelines.

So . . . the next time you turn in a work request, in the space provided for listing your previous jobs, please try to accurately note your past team experience. You don't need to list every time you've worked kitchen or agape (as long as it's more than 2 x's), but try to remember the talks you've given, how many times you've been in the talk room, all your boss experience (including Love Team), whether or not you've acted as sound technician, and so on.

Who should I sponsor?



The Walk to Emmaus is **definitely not for everyone**. The three-day Walks cannot heal every problem marriage, enthuse every disenchanted church member, or make saints out of sinners. The Walk to Emmaus is designed

to change local environments through Christian leadership. Prospective Pilgrims are Christ-centered individuals who are in **good health, mentally and emotionally stable, and have the ability to positively influence those around them**.
