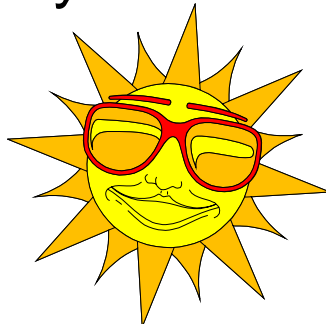

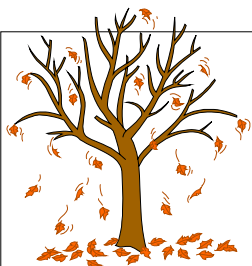

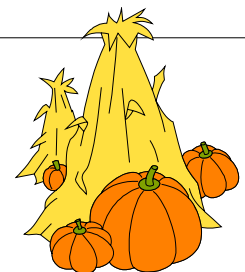

Team Service - Review

1. Those working on a live-in team for the very first time **must** attend both team meetings. There are no exceptions.
2. In order to be considered to serve as a team boss, a person must have served (1) on either the Agape or Kitchen team twice, (2) **and** served as a Silent Table Leader, (3) **and** served as a Designated Table Leader, Speaker or Cha Cha. (See *Emmaus Progression of Service Guidelines in this newsletter*)
3. Those who are serving on one of the live-in teams during a Walk, **must** stay on site all weekend.
4. **Only single-size** air mattresses, cots, aerobeds, etc., may be used. This applies to all team members and pilgrims.

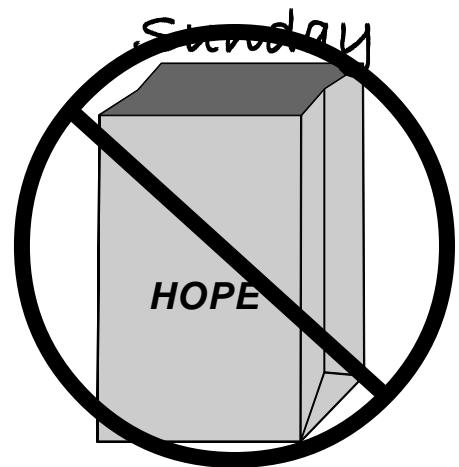
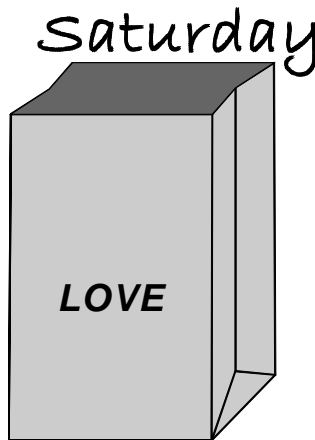
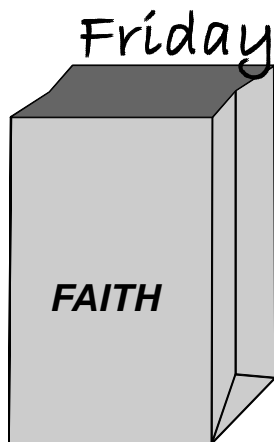
Does YOUR Pilgrim have special needs?

As a sponsor, you should make it one of your top priorities to find out, in advance, if your pilgrim has any special needs. These needs include things associated with diet, allergies, medication, hearing, sleeping, wheelchairs or walkers, stair limitations, etc. Because you want your pilgrim to have the best experience possible, it is **imperative** that you note all of their special needs on the "Pilgrim Application."

Special accommodations for sleeping and talk room placement, for example, are very difficult to comply with once the Walk begins. As far as dietary needs are concerned, **THEY CANNOT BE MODIFIED ONCE YOU ARE AT THE WALK**. You must pre-arrange for special diets. Thank you for your cooperation and attention.


TWO AGAPE DROPS AT 2009 WALKS

Agape drops will take place on Friday and Saturday **ONLY**-- the Sunday Agape drop has been eliminated. Why? Well the original intent of Emmaus Agape was to encourage those on the Walks through **hand-written notes and letters**. However, with three bags to fill, it seems like the notes took a back seat in favor of *stuff*. Now, with only two bags, the Board is hoping to relieve some of the pressure and allow the community to go back to note writing. There's always the option of pillow Agape . . . **If you have larger items of Agape for your Pilgrim, please consider delivering them after Closing or during the week following their Walk.** If a bag is too full (items spilling out and bag in danger of tearing), gifts will be taken out and returned to the sponsor.



Please remember: Since there will be no Sunday Agape drop, do not bring Agape to Candlelight and assume it will be delivered!

Emmaus Progression of Service GUIDELINES

Please note the additions designated by the  regarding the positions of Sound Tech and Love Team Boss.

1 First, you must serve at least twice on one of the **live-in action teams** (Kitchen or Agape).

2 This makes you qualified to serve as a **Silent Table Leader** in the Talk Room or as *Sound Tech.

Note: Table leader assignments are made with care and are given to those who have proven the ability to lead a group, understand Emmaus, listen, empathize, guide discussion and foster the development of the table family.

3 This makes you qualified to be a **Designated Table Leader** or a **Speaker** or a **Cha-Cha**.

- Please keep in mind that being qualified does not guarantee you a spot on any team. Each position is prayerfully considered.

4 This makes you qualified to serve as a **Core Team Boss** for a live-in action team (Kitchen, Agape, Cha-Cha, or Song Team) or for the Love Team.

- These guidelines are repeated in every newsletter as a reminder for those who may have forgotten and for those who are new to the Community.

5 To be an **Assistant Lay Director** you should have progressed through step 1-3 and have given at least one Talk.

6 To be qualified as a **Lay Director** candidate you must have progressed through steps 1-4, given two Talks, and served as a Cha-Cha or Assistant Lay Director. Lay Directors are prayerfully selected by the Board.

Please note:

****The position of Sound Tech requires special training and those individuals are considered members of the Song Team while on a Walk. This position is also considered equal with that of Silent Table Leader and thus qualifies those who serve as Sound Tech to be available to serve as a speaker or Cha Cha (No. 3 above).***

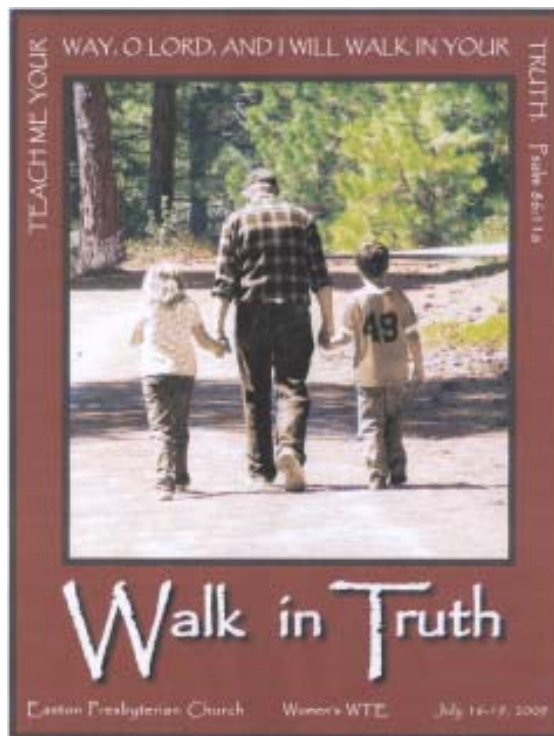

Meet Your Board

This is the first part of a new series which will be published in this newsletter. The purpose is to acquaint the community with each of the board positions -- who is currently holding them and what each job entails. Men & Women's Team Selection Coordinators: Scott Norvel & Susan Hornor

The Team Selection coordinators receive all the work requests, either via email or regular mail. They review them for completeness and forward them to the appropriate lay director. They work closely with the lay directors to ensure that team positions are assigned to workers who have fulfilled all the requirements to hold those positions. They also keep records of who has worked what -- which is why it is important to thoroughly complete each Work Request you turn in -- especially where you have worked and what talks you have given.

Newsletter Editor: Andrea Sweet

The newsletter is published approximately one-month prior to each set of Walks. It is the responsibility of the Newsletter editor to compile all information, graphically design each of the pages, get final okay for print from the executive committee, take the copy to the printer. Prepare the newsletter for mailing -- label, seal and sort. And finally deliver it to the Bulk Mail Dept. at the post office. Information used in the newsletter is obtained from the Board of Directors.
